The preferred candidate will have a completed doctorate in linguistics and will be able to speak one of the Cree, Ojibway, or Dakota languages, although the committee will consider applicants with a Master's degree and relevant experience in the field. Candidates are expected to demonstrate an active program of research as well as the ability to work in a collaborative, co-instructional teaching model with Aboriginal elders and speakers. Rank and salary will be commensurate with experience.
